PURPOSE:

These guidelines provide information for the establishment, operation and use of a repair facility for fire department vehicles.

RESPONSIBILITY:

All members should be familiar with these provisions. Officers shall be specifically aware of and using these provisions, while also maintaining their current knowledge of their use and implementation.

PROCEDURES:

The Maintenance Department Repair Facility (MDRF) shall be located at 8190 McEwen Road, Washington Township, Ohio. At this location, it will be housed in a one story, non-combustible construction type building that is fully suppressed and alarmed. Over 3,000 square feet of space is used for the servicing and repair of fire department vehicles.

At the MDRF, necessary internal systems for maintenance work, such as oil changing, wiring, lubricating, air pressurization, lifting and parts storage are present or installed. Sufficient quantities and types of hand tools are provided to perform all necessary regular service and repair work. Each year, replacement tools and equipment are acquired to replace and update current stocks, and as needs dictate.

Access to the MDRF is limited. Public access to the property and grounds is through an adjacent designated point that adjoins the MDRF. Other property access is limited by fencing/gates, and building control is through locked/monitored doorways.
