**Whereas**, Brian Kimble, operations manager of the LA Fitness club on West Alex Bell Road in Centerville/Washington Township, was among those who came to the aid of a man who underwent full cardiac arrest while playing racquet ball in November 2009 at the fitness club; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Kim Kwiatek, who was in the fitness club at the time, assessed the man's condition and administered life-saving cardio-pulmonary resuscitation; and

**WHEREAS**, Brian Kimble, along with General Manager Mark Woodring, noticed what was taking place and rushed to obtain the health club's Automated External Defibrillator; and

**WHEREAS**, Following the successful administration of CPR and defibrillation, the man's pulse returned and he regained consciousness while in transport to the hospital.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** by the Washington Township Board of Trustees, Montgomery County, Ohio, that Brian Kimble be commended for helping to save a man's life, for his advance preparation, for a quick and competent response, and for his teamwork with others on the scene.
