CAPTAIN BILL DEVIR RETIREMENT

Whereas, Captain Bill Devir is retiring after more than 37 years of service with the Washington Township Fire Department, including the last 16 years as Part-Time EMS Captain; and

WHEREAS, Bill joined Washington Township in 1979 as a Part-Time EMT, was promoted to EMS Captain in July 2000, and also has served as a Part-Paid Volunteer Firefighter from 1999 through 2015 and as a Part-Time In-House Firefighter from 1995 through 1996; and

WHEREAS, his contributions to the department have included serving as an assessor on squad leader interview boards, serving on the Ambulance Specification Committee, and completing Regional Task Force Active Shooter Training; and


WHEREAS, on behalf of the department, he has served on the Greater Miami Valley EMS Council, acted as a liaison to local extended care facilities, and provided representation to the Greater Cincinnati Fusion Center, a regional cooperative effort among public safety and health agencies to combat potential terrorist activity; and


WHEREAS, beyond his Fire Department duties, he serves as Unit Commander for Ohio 5 Disaster Medical Assistance Team, a federal response unit of health care professionals who provide medical disaster response for incidents such as hurricanes Katrina and Sandy.


