Whereas, on December 16, 2016, a member of the Watts Middle School staff experienced full cardiac arrest while in the classroom; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Dispatcher received the 9-1-1 call and provided lifesaving direction to Watts Middle School colleagues who performed cardio-pulmonary resuscitation, defibrillated the patient, and restored his pulse; and


WHEREAS, Washington Township Fire Department emergency personnel followed up with supportive care and transportation to Southview Medical Center; and


WHEREAS, because of the direct and immediate actions of Watts Middle School staff, the fire dispatcher and emergency medical responders, the patient's life was saved.


