## LIFE-SAVING ACTIONS

**Whereas,** on December 3, 2016, two vehicles collided head-on near 6318 Far Hills Avenue and the driver of the pickup truck experienced full cardiac arrest; and

**WHEREAS,** City of Centerville Police Officers Brian Sears and Lt. Matt Brown gained access to the truck and applied an automatic external defibrillator to the driver while bystanders Elizabeth Brown and Tracy Reed-Trueblood administered cardio-pulmonary resuscitation; and


**WHEREAS,** when Washington Township Fire Department emergency personnel -- Tony Fleet, Capt. Mike Guadagno, Nick Griffin, Janice Harris, Rusty Lovell, Tad Parks, Melissa Renaud and Lt. Ben Zacharias -- arrived at the scene, they took over CPR and defibrillated the patient, then continued Advanced Cardiac Life Support; and


**WHEREAS,** because of the direct and immediate actions of citizen bystanders, the police department and the fire department, the patient regained a life-sustaining heart rhythm; and


