DEPUTY MICHAEL BEACH LIFE-SAVING ACTIONS

Whereas, on March 19, 2017, Deputies Kyle Chmiel and Michael Beach were dispatched to a Washington Township neighborhood where a man was lying in the grass next to the sidewalk, with someone giving chest compressions; and

WHEREAS, the deputies checked for a pulse and, when one was not detected, used an automated external defibrillator to analyze the man's heart rhythm; and


WHEREAS, when the AED advised against applying shock, the deputies then administered cardio-pulmonary resuscitation until the Washington Township Fire Department medic crew arrived at the scene; and


WHEREAS, because of the direct and immediate actions of Deputies Chmiel and Beach, the man was transported safely to the hospital and began breathing again on his own.




