## DAYTON AREA CHAPTER THE AMERICAN RED CROSS

**Whereas**, the Dayton Area Chapter of the American Red Cross has provided disaster relief, education and transportation, as well as youth, community, military and international services continuously in the Miami Valley for 94 years; and

**WHEREAS**, volunteers from the Dayton Area Chapter responded in 2010 to 170 local emergencies involving 731 disaster victims, trained 19,958 people in life-saving skills, and provided assistance across the country for those impacted by natural disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency housing programs provided by the Dayton Area Chapter of the American Red Cross assisted 207 families, including 401 children during 2010; and




