
WHEREAS, on July 26, 1990, President George H. Bush signed into law the Americans with Disabilities Act to ensure the civil rights of people with disabilities; and




WHEREAS, the full promise of the ADA will only be reached if public entities remain committed in their efforts to implement its provisions.
