Whereas, Ashlie Mays of Vandalia, Ohio came to the aid December 8 of a man who underwent full cardiac arrest at the corner of Lyons Road and Miamisburg-Centerville Road in Washington Township; and

WHEREAS, Ashlie Mays, an off-duty paramedic, administered life-saving cardio-pulmonary resuscitation, thus keeping the man alive until a Washington Township medic crew could arrive on the scene; and


WHEREAS, After medic crews arrived, she continued to assist by applying CPR and by preparing patches for use with the automated-external defibrillator so that Captain Ron Kern could focus on securing the man's airway; and


WHEREAS, Following the successful administration of CPR and external defibrillation, the man's pulse returned and he has since made a full recovery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Washington Township Board of Trustees, Montgomery County, Ohio, that Ashlie Mays be commended for helping to save a man's life through her quick, selfless and competent response and through her teamwork with others on the scene.
