
WHEREAS, in addition to scouting, Murry is active in the Centerville High School a cappella group, Forte, and has performed in numerous high school theater productions; and



WHEREAS, Murry Chelette of Washington Township, Ohio has been recognized with the prestigious Eagle Scout Award from the Boy Scouts of America.

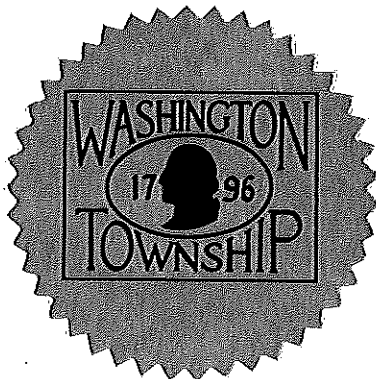


