WHEREAS, in 1959 the Washington Township Board of Trustees put the issue of a Park District on the ballot and the residents of Washington Township voted to create the Park District; and


WHEREAS, the importance of open space to our community is just as significant today as it was when the first park commissioners were appointed to develop the Park District for our growing community; and


WHEREAS, the Park District has been an excellent steward of that open space during the last fifty years.




