
WHEREAS, at Centerville High School, Stuart is a member of the National Honor Society and Spanish Honor Society and played football for four years, including three years as a varsity center; and



WHEREAS, Stuart Moss of Washington Township, Ohio has been recognized with the prestigious Eagle Scout Award from the Boy Scouts of America.

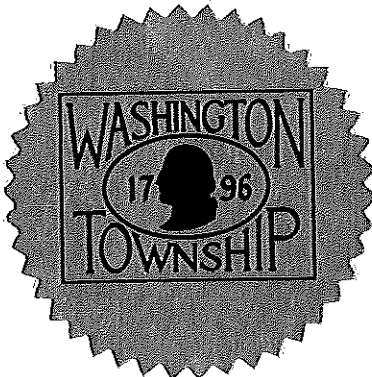
