Backstage Job Descriptions

Training is available for all crew positions. Unless otherwise noted, crew members are required to attend all tech/dress rehearsals (the week before performances) and all performances.

Assistant Stage Manager:

Assistant Stage Managers (ASMs) help the stage manager run rehearsals by assisting in set up and clean-up, taking blocking notes, tracking technical changes, running sound, etc. During tech and performances, ASMs work with the crew chief to assist the stage manager in the smooth running of backstage and keeping the show consistent each performance. ASMs are expected to attend all rehearsals & performances. ASMs are also expected to arrive 10 minutes early to rehearsal to help with set-up and stay a few minutes after to help with clean-up.

Light Board Operator:

Light Board Operators run the light board during tech & dress rehearsals and performances, learn about programming, and checks the lights before every show to make sure everything is working properly.

Spotlight Operator:

Spotlight Operators should be able to smoothly operate the spotlight during tech and performances, with the instruction of the lighting designer and stage manager.

Sound Board Operator/A1:

Sound Board Operators run the sound board for tech and performances by mixing the sound for the show, including microphones, music, and special effects. They also assist an adult crew member in putting mics on cast members and maintaining the mics.

Backstage/Run Crew:

Backstage/Run crew work behind the scenes with the ASMs and crew chief during tech & dress rehearsals and performances to track props, help with scene changes, and keep the show running consistently and smoothly.

Properties Crew:

If Town Hall is doing a production with a large amount of props, a separate crew member will be assigned to props. Duties include tracking props backstage, checking props in before and after every performance, and setting and striking props during scene changes. Properties crew members also assist the backstage crew.

Wardrobe/Costume Crew:

Wardrobe crew members assist the wardrobe supervisor with hair, make-up, and costumes before, during, and after the show during dress rehearsals and performances, including any quick changes. Costume construction internships may also be available on a show-by-show basis. Contact the stage manager if interested.

Audition Assistant:

Audition assistants help the stage manager during auditions by helping check auditionees in, collect and organize audition materials, run sound, etc.

Student Designer:

Student designer positions begin up to three months before a show opens. The following student designer positions are available for the 2023-2024 Season:

- Lighting Designer: available for Goldilocks on Trial and Puss in Boots
 - Responsible for creating all the light looks for the show, creating paperwork, attending meetings, and more. Applicants should have prior experience.
- Assistant Lighting Designer: available for Peter Pan and Finding Nemo Jr.
 - Responsible for assisting the Lighting Designer in creating paperwork, attending meetings, programming and more.
- **Sound Designer:** available for *Goldilocks on Trial* and *Puss in Boots*
 - Responsible for creating or sourcing all sound effects for the show, creating paperwork, attending meetings, working with Qlab, and more.
- **Assistant Sound Designer:** available for *Peter Pan* and *Finding Nemo Jr*.
 - o Responsible for assisting the Sound Designer in creating paperwork, attending meetings, and more.
